Logical Fallacy Assignment

You will be assigned one or two logical fallacies to research and present to the class in two ways.

- **I.** Make a short **six** slide PowerPoint presentation for each fallacy assigned to introduce the concept, provide a definition, and provide three examples of the fallacy. Two of the three must have been real and reported via a media agency. **Use parenthetical references** for all information you provide. Your final slide is a Works Cited page. You will organize it like this:
- **Slide 1** Title of fallacy and etymology if it applies (cite source)
- Slide 2 Definition of fallacy (cite source if different from the one given)
- **Slide 3** Example 1 of fallacy (fictional **or** real)
- **Slide 4** Example 2 of fallacy (*real* with source cited)
- **Slide 5** Example 3 of fallacy (*real* with source cited)
- **Slide 6** Works Cited page including all sources.
- II. Make a neat poster on 8.5x11 paper. YOU will mount the poster on black paper to reveal a ½ inch black border around all sides. The poster will include the following in **LARGE** print:
- 1) Name of fallacy and etymology if applicable
- 2) Full and accurate definition of the fallacy from an academic source
- **3**) Example of the fallacy from an actual article **WITH SOURCE CITED** in small letters underneath the example.
- **4)** An explanation as to why this example you present **IS** an effective example of the fallacy. Discuss with specific details from the example.

NOTE: Try to center and space your work on your poster and slides so it is visually appealing and balanced. Think about it as a media composition - placement, font, color, etc. Neatness and an appeal to aesthetics are important for a good grade on this assignment.
